Electro-Glass Products expanded its product base in April 2005 when it acquired the hot-molded glass operations of Kilburn Isotronics Inc, Chartley, Massachusetts.

This process, which was founded in 1897, adds a new dimension in glass processing to the Electro-Glass repertoire of products. The company can now offer *lenses, microwave windows, glass ball bearings, and sight windows*. In addition, many hundred sets of tooling included in this acquisition allows Electro-Glass to offer *rods with flat or beveled ends, cone lenses, and a multitude of special shapes and configurations never before available from Electro-Glass Products, in clear optical quality.*

The most popular materials used at this time in daily production include 7070 *Devitrifying*

Borosilicate; ARS Crystal Soda Lime; and 7740 Borosilicate Pyrex glasses. Other glass materials will be considered upon request.

All items manufactured with this process are classified as having a *fire-polish finish* on all convex and concave surfaces. Plano surfaces can be ground or optically polished in accordance with customer requirements. Plano surface diffusion is also offered.
